| advertisement | An <b>advertisement</b> is a public promotion of some product or service.   |
| sport         | <b>Sport</b> is the occupation of athletes who compete for pay.   |
| circulation   | <b>Circulation</b> is the dissemination of copies of periodicals (as newspapers or magazines).  |
| column        | A <b>column</b> is an article giving opinions or perspectives.  |
| editorial     | An <b>editorial</b> is an article giving opinions or perspectives.  |
| headline      | A <b>headline</b> is the heading or caption of a newspaper article.   |
| interview     | An <b>interview</b> is the questioning of a person.   |
| news          | <b>News</b> is information about recent and important events,.  |
| newsprint     | <b>Newsprint</b> is cheap paper made from wood pulp and used for printing newspapers.   |
| obituary      | An <b>obituary</b> is a notice of someone's death that usually includes a short biography.  |
| press         | Compress means to make something smaller by pressing it.  |
| weather       | <b>Weather</b> is the atmospheric conditions that comprise the state of the atmosphere in terms of temperature and wind and clouds and precipitation. |
| forecast      | The <b>forecast</b> is a prediction of what the weather will be like.   |
