| apple | An apple is a round fruit with red or green skin and crisp flesh. |
| cantaloupe | A cantaloupe is a small to medium-sized melon with yellowish flesh. |
| cherry | A cherry is a red fruit with a single hard stone. |
| grape | A grape is a juicy fruit that grows in clusters and is usually green or purple. |
| guava | A guava is a tropical fruit with yellow skin and pink pulp. |
| lemon | A lemon is a yellow citrus fruit. |
| peach | A peach is a downy juicy fruit with sweet yellowish or whitish flesh. |
| raspberry | A raspberry is a reddish aggregate berry. |
| strawberry | A strawberry is a sweet fleshy red fruit. |
| lime | A lime is a green citrus fruit. |
| orange | An orange is a type of citrus fruit. |
| pear | A pear is a sweet juicy fruit available in many varieties. |
| apricot | An apricot is a sweet fruit that resembles a small peach. |
| blueberry | A blueberry is a sweet edible dark-blue berry. |
| cranberry | A cranberry is a very tart red berry used for sauce or juice. |
| melon | A melon is a fruit of the gourd family with a hard rind and sweet juicy flesh. |
