

Spelling list: Musical instruments

accordion	An accordion is a box-shaped instrument with reeds and a bellow.
dulcimer	A dulcimer is a stringed instrument used in American folk music.
fiddle	A fiddle is a bowed stringed instrument that is the highest member of the violin family.
flute	A flute is a high-pitched woodwind instrument.
guitar	A guitar is a stringed instrument that's played by strumming or plucking.
harmonica	A harmonica is a small rectangular free-reed instrument that's played by blowing into the desired hole.
horn	A horn is a brass musical instrument with a brilliant tone.
keyboard	A keyboard is an electronic instrument with keys arranged like that of a piano.
music	Music is an artistic form of auditory communication incorporating instrumental or vocal tones in a structured and continuous manner.
musical	Musical describes something that is related to music.
note	A note is a symbol that represents pitch and duration of a musical sound.
oboe	An oboe is a slender a slender woodwind instrument with a conical bore and a reed mouthpiece.
piano	A piano is a keyboard instrument that is played by depressing keys that cause hammers to strike tuned strings and produce sounds.
reed	A reed is a musical instrument that sounds by means of a vibrating reed .
pipe	A pipe is a tubular wind instrument.

string **String** refers to stringed instruments that are played with a bow.

violin A **violin** is bowed stringed instrument that is the highest member of the **violin** family.
