

## Spelling list: Home, dining room

chair	A <b>chair</b> is a seat for a person.
cup	A <b>cup</b> is a small open container usually used for drinking.
pot	A <b>pot</b> is a metal or earthenware cooking vessel that is usually round and deep.
table	A <b>table</b> is a piece of furniture supported by legs with a flat surface for working or eating on.
plate	A <b>plate</b> is a dish on which food is served or from which food is eaten.
dinner	<b>Dinner</b> is the main meal of the day served in the evening or at midday.
dish	A <b>dish</b> is a container normally used for holding and serving food.
lamp	A <b>lamp</b> is a piece of furniture holding one or more electric light bulbs.
tray	A <b>tray</b> is an open receptacle for holding, displaying, or serving articles or food.
saucer	A <b>saucer</b> is a small shallow dish for holding a cup at the table.
sideboard	A <b>sideboard</b> is a piece of furniture that stands at the side of a dining room.
bowl	A <b>bowl</b> is a dish that is round and open at the top for serving food.
tabletop	A <b>tabletop</b> is the top horizontal work surface of a table.
glass	A <b>glass</b> is a container for holding liquids while drinking.
