

Spelling list: Words ending in *dle*

The /d l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *dle* .

cradle	Each baby was placed in a cradle .
ladle	Ladle the soup into a bowl.
doodle	The artist was bored so she drew a quick doodle .
noodle	I use a noodle to help me float in the swimming pool.
poodle	Her first dog was a poodle .
needle	It's like finding a needle in a haystack.
paddle	It was a beautiful day to paddle in the sea.
fiddle	A violin is sometimes called a fiddle .
middle	Central Park is in the middle of New York City.
riddle	Can you solve the riddle ?
cuddle	The baby would like a cuddle .
muddle	The recipe was complicated and the chef got into a muddle .
puddle	I jumped in the puddle .
candle	Be careful not to burn yourself on the candle .
handle	Grip the handle with both hands.
dwindle	The resort's population will dwindle in winter.
swindle	The businessman was planning to swindle the investors.
bundle	I gathered a bundle of sticks for the fire.
