This word list focuses on initial consonant blends. An initial consonant blend occurs when two consonants are combined at the beginning of a word to create a specific sound. Each example will show you how these blends are used in simple sentences, while helping you learn and understand new words.

stop We couldn't **stop** laughing.

spin We watched the spider **spin** its web.

snip She took a moment to **snip** the loose threads from the hem of the dress.

snap Even though he was frustrated, he tried not to **snap** .

crop The farmer was growing a **crop** of wheat.

step She took a **step** toward him.

stag The **stag** has big antlers.

stem I trimmed the flower's **stem** .
