irregular	<b>Irregular</b> shapes have sides of unequal length.
rhombus	A <b>Rhombus</b> has four sides of equal length but no right angles.
rotate	Let us <b>rotate</b> the wheel.
rotation	<b>Rotation</b> is where you twist or turn something round.
square	A <b>square</b> is a shape with four equal straight sides and four right angles.
subtraction	We also did lots of mental <b>subtraction</b> and addition.
symmetry	Line <b>symmetry</b> is when a line drawn through a shape leaves each side a mirror image of the other.
symmetrical	To be <b>symmetrical</b> is when one shape becomes exactly like another if you flip, slide or turn it.
triangle	Draw a <b>triangle</b> with three equal sides.
triangular	The village green is <b>triangular</b> in shape.
tonne	A <b>tonne</b> is 1,000 kilograms.
vertex	The two lines meet, creating a <b>vertex</b> .
vertices	The two types of principal <b>vertices</b> are called 'ears' and 'mouths'.
vertical	A <b>vertical</b> cliff is a precipice.
volume	<b>Volume</b> is usually measured in cubic centimeters.
weight	To win the cake you must guess its <b>weight</b> .
