

Spelling list: Adding a suffix after a vowel consonant pattern.

When adding a suffix to a short word, or one whose last letter is stressed, look at the letter before the last letter. If the letter is a vowel, we usually double the last letter. For example: "stop" becomes "stopped."

pedal The **pedal** came off my bike.

pedalling

pedalled We **pedalled** as fast as we could.

prevail

prevailing

prevailed

model Our class built a **model** from clay.

modelling Mrs Nobles presses the **modelling** clay together to make it flat.

modelled

submit Complete your application form and **submit** it before it is due.

submitted

submitting
