hanged They **hanged** the prisoner last week. (hang - **hanged** - hanged)

hid Last week, my sister **hid** her toys from me. (hide - **hid** - hidden)

hit She **hit** her head last week. (hit - **hit** - hit)

held I **held** my newborn baby sister yesterday. (hold - **held** - held)

hurt I **hurt** my knee yesterday. (hurt - **hurt** - hurt)
