

## Spelling list: ow words (copy)

On the end of a word the most common way to spell the long /o/ sound is with the letters ow.

blow	I am going <b>blow</b> up a yellow balloon.
flow	Water will <b>flow</b> down the plug hole when you empty the sink.
show	When you go to the cinema you have to <b>show</b> your ticket.
throw	Don't <b>throw</b> your clothes on the floor.
arrow	The <b>arrow</b> pointed to the way out.
below	He lives in the rooms <b>below</b> me.
borrow	Could I <b>borrow</b> some milk?
elbow	I have hurt my <b>elbow</b> when I fell.
fellow	That <b>fellow</b> keeps looking at me.
follow	Don't <b>follow</b> me, I'm lost.
hollow	The tree trunk was <b>hollow</b> .
meadow	Cows are grazing in the <b>meadow</b> .
narrow	Our car got stuck in a <b>narrow</b> lane.
pillow	I like to sleep with a big <b>pillow</b> .
shadow	The evening sun cast a long <b>shadow</b> .
shallow	I like to swim in <b>shallow</b> water because I feel safer.
sorrow	<b>Sorrow</b> is a feeling of great sadness.
swallow	It is hard to <b>swallow</b> when your throat is sore.
bungalow	They lived in a small <b>bungalow</b> by the sea.
