

Spelling list: Shakespeare- Sonnets and Soliloquies

Shakespeare	Shakespeare was a famous playwright and poet.
Sonnet	A sonnet is a type of poem. It has 14 lines.
iambic	Iambic metre follows an unstressed then stressed pattern.
pentameter	Pentameter is a poetic meter which uses five metrical feet per line.
metre	Metre is the basic rhythmic structure of a poem.
soliloquy	A soliloquy allows us into the mind of the character.

playwright	A playwright writes plays.
Shakespearean	The Merchant of Venice is a Shakespearean tragedy.
idealized	The woman is often idealized in a sonnet.
rhyme	These words all rhyme: time, crime, chime.
rhythm	James plays rhythm guitar.
syllable	A syllable is a beat in a word.
Elizabethan	The Merchant of Venice is an Elizabethan play.
